

Trainee Dispensing Optician

A Dispensing Optician (DO) is a qualified optical professional specialising in the supply of optical lenses and spectacles. - Contact lens management and teaching patients how to insert and remove contact lenses.
- With time and training, doing spectacle adjustments, repairs and advising customers on frame choice and spectacle lenses. Also, problem solving for patient issues and concerns.
- 3 year ABDO distance learning diploma course in Ophthalmic dispensing including four weeks block release per academic year at ABDO college in Godmersham, Kent. All fee's, travel and accommodation included in training package.
- Once professional qualification completed future expansion, both clinically and in a business role, is likely.

For this position, no previous experience is needed as full training will be given. Academic dispensing training will be undertaken through the ABDO three year diploma (FBDO). This will require an aptitude for maths and science and higher qualifications are necessary for entry to the dispensing course. You need to be positive, articulate and polite as well as being a good multitasker and problem solver. You must be good with people, have an organized approach and always be happy to help. Wearing spectacles and contact lenses is useful but is, by no means, essential.
